Santa Catalina Monastery	Historical & Religious	Calle Santa Catalina 301, Cercado	A “city within a city,” featuring vividly colored streets built from sillar (volcanic ashlar stone).
Plaza de Armas and Arequipa Cathedral	Historical & Cultural	Plaza de Armas, Cercado	The heart of the city, surrounded by colonial arcades and historic buildings built from white sillar stone and the majestic Cathedral.
Yanahuara Viewpoint	Scenic viewpoint	Cta. del Ángel 513, Yanahuara	A scenic viewpoint offering panoramic views of Arequipa and its surrounding volcanoes, framed by traditional carved sillar arches.
Mundo Alpaca	Experiential museum	Alameda San Lázaro 101, Cercado	An immersive museum experience showcasing alpaca fibers, traditional Andean textiles, and live alpacas and llamas.
Andean Sanctuaries Museum	Archaeological attraction	Calle La Merced 110, Cercado	Home to the famous Inca mummy “Juanita,” the Ice Maiden, with exhibits exploring Inca rituals, high-altitude archaeology, and Andean cosmology.
La Compañía Cloisters	Architectural attraction	Calle Gral. Morán 118, Cercado	A notable example of mestizo baroque architecture, featuring carved sillar patios and restored colonial cloisters now home to artisan boutiques.
San Camilo Market	Cultural & Gastronomic	Calle San Camilo, Cercado	A lively traditional market designed by Gustave Eiffel, showcasing local produce, street food, and everyday life in Arequipa—ideal for sampling fresh juices and tropical fruits.
